Re: Arrangements for September

As you will be aware from recent announcements from the government, we will be able to return to a more usual pattern in school at the start of next year. We will no longer have to maintain class 'bubbles' or arrangements relating to this e.g. staggered start and finish times.

We will maintain hygiene and cleaning regimes, alongside one or two other protocols. The government plan is to isolate only those children who have tested positive for Coronavirus. It seems that other contacts in school will take a test (or tests) and will be able to attend if they do not have any symptoms or record a positive test. Further details are likely to follow.

Please note that any child who has symptoms of Coronavirus should not attend school and should take a PCR test. Please let us know as soon as possible in this case.
